<b>Entry Requirements</b>	Entry is only available to Bayside Council residents or, for the '12 and Under (Schools)' category, schools that are located within the Bayside Council area. Entrants under 16 years of age must seek permission from their parent or guardian to enter.
<b>Ineligible Entrants</b>	All Bayside Council staff and their family members residing in the same home.
<b>Competition Period</b>	11 November 2024 12:01am to 12 December 11:59pm 2024
<b>How to Enter</b>	<p>Bayside Council is inviting its community to showcase their creativity through an upcycling challenge. Participants are encouraged to transform old items into something new and functional, with prizes awarded in the following categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Most Creative (13 and over)</li> <li>* Most Practical (13 and over)</li> <li>*12 and Under (Individual)</li> <li>*12 and Under (Schools)</li> </ul> <p><b>Step 1.</b> Select which category will be most suitable for your project and create an item made from upcycled materials with the purpose of turning it into something else.</p> <p><b>Step 2.</b> Once your upcycled piece is complete, register your project through our online form prior to the submission close date and time (12 December 11:59pm 2024). Be sure to include photos and a description of your creation.</p>
<b>Verification Requirements</b>	Registration with name, project
<b>Maximum Number of Entries</b>	One per person or team per project.
<b>Prize Selected by Panel of Judges</b>	<p><b>Winners</b> One winner will be selected for each category, with judging based on creativity, functionality, and innovation. The winners will be chosen by a panel of three industry professionals, bringing their expertise in design, sustainability, and craftsmanship to evaluate the submissions.</p> <p>The judging will happen after submissions are closed on 12 December 11:59pm 2024 and may take up to 10 days for deliberation. Once a decision is made winners will be contacted.</p> <p>Names of the winners may be published in communications.</p>
<b>Prize Details</b>	<p>Each winner in the following categories will receive a \$200 ClassBento gift voucher:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Most Creative (13 and over)</li> <li>* Most Practical (13 and over)</li> <li>* 12 and Under (Individual)</li> </ul> <p>ClassBento is an online platform that connects people with creative, hands-on workshops run by local artisans and experts. These workshops offer</p>

	<p>sustainable experiences in arts, crafts, cooking, and wellness, supporting local communities and promoting eco-friendly practices.</p> <p>The winner of the 12 and Under (Schools) category will get to choose an item worth up to \$400 from the Compost Revolution catalogue, with Council providing onsite setup assistance and a demonstration.</p>

<b>Total Prize Pool</b>	Up to \$1000 for four prizes.
