Bayside Council recognises the rights of children and young people to feel safe when accessing Council services.

Council is committed to creating and maintaining an environment that promotes the safety and wellbeing of all children and young people.

Child protection is everyone's business. If you see something, say something.

Contact the police if a child or young person is at immediate risk of abuse - **phone 000**

If you suspect on reasonable grounds that a child or young person is at risk of significant harm, report your concerns. You can:
